Racial/Ethnic Dot Density By Census Block Group

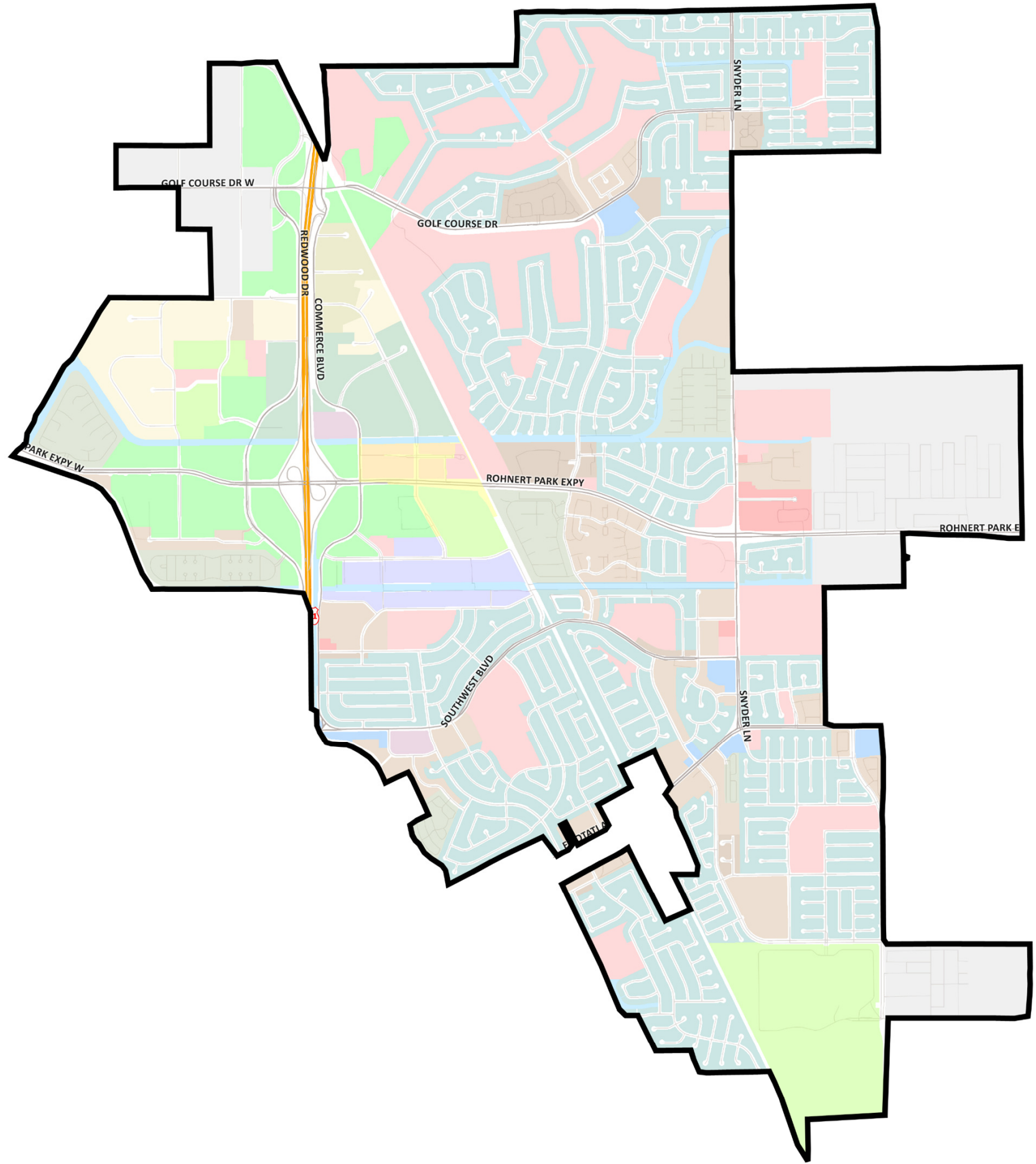
