

RESOLUTION NO. 2014-150

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF ROHNERT PARK
AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING CHANGING CITY OF ROHNERT PARK
MEDICARE RETIREE PRESCRIPTION DRUG PLAN VENDOR FROM
CVS/CAREMARK TO EXPRESS SCRIPTS EFFECTIVE FEBRUARY 1, 2015**

WHEREAS, the City of Rohnert Park desires to offer its Medicare eligible retirees receiving prescription coverage through CVS/Caremark a prescription drug plan at a lower cost than the current plan; and

WHEREAS, Express Scripts contracts with the Centers for Medicaid and Medicare Services to serve as a Medicare Part D Plan Sponsor; and

WHEREAS, as a Medicare Part D Plan Sponsor Express Scripts receives federal subsidies and discounts from pharmaceutical companies which are used to reduce Express Scripts premiums; and

WHEREAS, the City and retirees, who must contribute some portion of their medical/prescription coverage, will experience savings in lower monthly premiums and deductibles by changing to the Express Scripts prescription drug plan.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Rohnert Park hereby approves changing City of Rohnert Park Medicare retiree prescription drug plan vendor from CVS/Caremark to Express Scripts effective February 1, 2015.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager is authorized and directed to execute any necessary documents to effectuate the change of retiree prescription drug plan vendor for and on behalf of the City of Rohnert Park.
