RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF ROHNERT PARK AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE TASK ORDER NO. 2014-01 WITH GREEN VALLEY CONSULTING ENGINEERS FOR CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT AND INSPECTION SERVICES IN CONNECTION WITH ROHNERT PARK EXPRESSWAY 16-INCH WATER TRANSMISSION MAIN PROJECT NO. 2004-08

WHEREAS, the City of Rohnert Park (City) Municipal Code Title 3 Chapter 3.04 provides that the city's purchasing functions shall be governed by the city's purchasing policy; and

WHEREAS, on January 26, 2011, City and Green Valley Consulting Engineers ("Consultant") entered into that certain agreement entitled "*Design Professional Services Agreement*" ("Agreement") to provide general engineering services related to the City, pursuant to City Council Resolution No. 2011-07; and

WHEREAS, on April 9, 2014, City and Consultant entered into Task Order No. 2014-01 for Construction Management and Inspection Services relating to the construction of Rohnert Park Expressway 16-Inch Water Transmission Main, Project No. 2004-08 for the amount of \$291,588.00 authorized per City Council Resolution No. 2014-139; and

WHEREAS, City and Consultant now desire to enter into a First Amendment to the Task Order No. 2014-01 for Construction Management and Inspection Services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROHNERT PARK AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. That the above recitations are true and correct and material to this Resolution.

Section 2. Environmental Clearance. That the adoption of this Resolution and accompanying Amendment is exempt from review under the California Environmental Quality Act because the activity in question is not a project as defined under CEQA Guidelines Section 15378 in that there is no potential that the activity will result in either a direct physical change in the environment or a reasonably foreseeable indirect physical change in the environment.

Section 3. Agreement. That the First Amendment to the Task Order No. 2014-01 between Green Valley Consulting Engineers and the City of Rohnert Park is hereby authorized and approved in an amount not to exceed an additional Fifty Nine Thousand Three Hundred Ten Dollars and No Cents (\$59,310.00).

Section 4. Authorization. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to take all actions to effectuate the First Amendment to the Task Order No. 2014-01 for and on behalf of the City of Rohnert Park, including execution if necessary, in substantially similar form to the First Amendment attached hereto and incorporated by this reference as Exhibit "A," subject to minor modifications by the City Manager or City Attorney.

AMENDMENT 1 TO TASK ORDER NO. 2014-01 CITY OF ROHNERT PARK AND GREEN VALLEY CONSULTING ENGINEERS

AUTHORIZATION TO PROVIDE CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT AND INSPECTION SERVICES FOR THE ROHNERT PARK EXPRESSWAY WATER TRANSMISSION MAIN PROJECT NO. 2004-08

SECTION 1 – PURPOSE

The purpose of this First Amendment to Task Order No. 2014-01 is to authorize and direct Green Valley Consulting Engineers to proceed with the additional work specified in Section 2 below in accordance with the provisions of the MASTER AGREEMENT between the City of Rohnert Park ("City") and Green Valley Consulting Engineers ("Consultant") hereto dated January 26, 2011.

SECTION 2 – SCOPE OF WORK

The additional items authorized by this Task Order are generally described as; the increase in Construction Management (CM), prevailing wage inspection time, and associated reimbursable expenses, which are above administration of the original construction contract due to the added working days for a number of items. Most significant additional items are; added curb ramps to the project, additional surface paving along Rohnert Park Expressway (RPX) at SMART Railroad crossing and miscellaneous extra work items. A brief summary of the additional construction items which added workdays to the construction contract are described as follows:

1. Contract Change Order (CCO) #1 added 14 working days for additional curb ramps.
2. CCO #2 added 3 working days for tree trimming, valve and pipe restraints and other miscellaneous work.
3. CCO ## added 3 working days for SCWA Hot Tap work, fire hydrant upgrades and other miscellaneous work.
4. CCO #4 added 28 working days for additional area drains at the 101 Off-Ramp Sidewalk, surface paving at the SMART RPX Railroad Crossing.
5. On-going coordination with City staff and Contractor during project close-out procedures.
6. Reimbursable expensed for the additional working days on Contract (vehicles, copies, etc.)

SECTION 3 – COMPENSATION AND PAYMENT

Compensation shall be as provided in the MASTER AGREEMENT between the parties hereto referenced in SECTION 1 above. The additional cost for the additional services as set forth in SECTION 2 shall be actual costs (time and materials) based on Consultants' standard labor charges in accordance with the provisions of the MASTER AGREEMENT and as shown in Exhibit "A" for an amount not-to-exceed \$59,310.

Total compensation under this Task Order with this Amendment shall not exceed \$350,898.

SECTION 4 – TIME OF PERFORMANCE

The work described in SECTION 2 shall be completed during Fiscal Year 2014/15 or as

extended by the City Engineer or her designee.

SECTION 5 – ITEMS AND CONDITIONS

Except as specifically modified and amended in this First Amendment, all terms and conditions contained in the MASTER AGREEMENT for professional services between City and Consultant remain in full force and effect and binding upon the parties.
