A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ROHNERT PARK CHANGING THE NAME OF THE "BICYCLE ADVISORY COMMITTEE" TO "BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN ADVISORY COMMITTEE"

WHEREAS, the Rohnert Park Bicycle Advisory Committee was established in 1992 through a Minute Action of the Rohnert Park City Council to comply with Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) Resolution No. 875 governing Transportation Development Act, Article 3 ("TDA Article 3") funding for bicycle and pedestrian facilities and requiring that cities have a Bicycle Advisory Committee to review projects proposed to be funded with TDA Article 3 monies; and

WHEREAS, MTC Resolution No. 875 was superseded in 2013 by MTC Resolution No. 4108 which retained the requirement for cities to have a Bicycle Advisory Committee, and which added that such committee should be composed of both bicyclists and pedestrians; and

WHEREAS, the Complete Streets Policy adopted by the City Council in 2012 calls for "Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee" consultation to verify bicycle and pedestrian needs for projects early in the planning and design stages of projects.

WHEREAS, Policy 1.3 of the Rohnert Park Bicycle and Pedestrian Master Plan ("Bike/Ped Master Plan") adopted by the City Council in 2008 calls for the Bicycle Advisory Committee to be expanded to that of a "Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee."

WHEREAS, the City desires to continue the Bicycle Advisory Committee but also desires to change the name of the "Bicycle Advisory Committee" to "Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee."

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Rohnert Park hereby changes the name of the "Bicycle Advisory Committee" to the "Bicycle and Pedestrian Advisory Committee."
